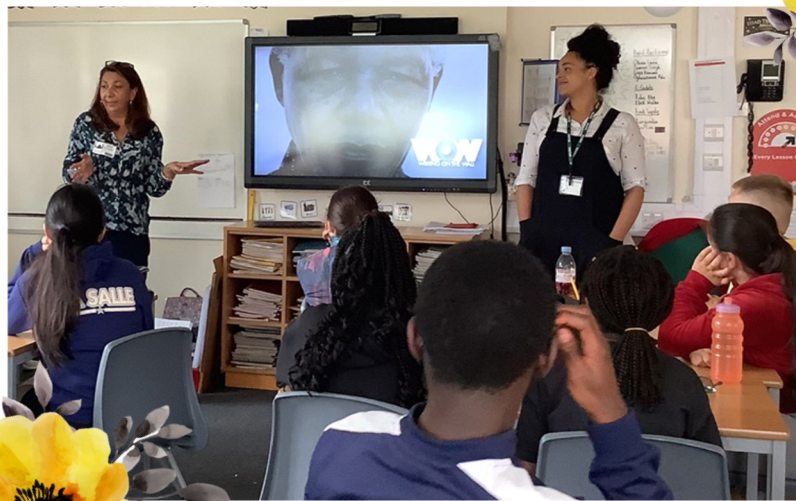

## YEAR 1

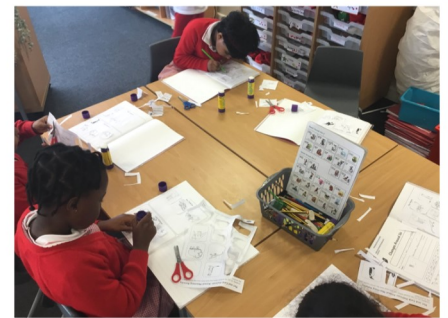
