THURSDAY 8.30pm ITV1: WHAT ARE WE EATING?

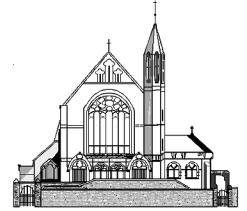

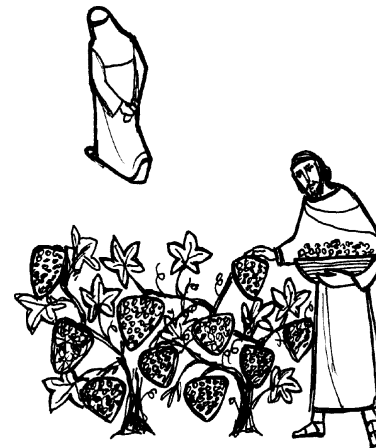
