School perimeter – our boundaries are safe & secure. We identify & record all visitors & make sure they understand our policy on safeguarding. All staff, students regular visitors and volunteers complete safeguarding DBS checks.

Attendance is checked daily to make sure your child has arrived safely. All children should be accounted for by 09.30am. If we have not heard from parents/carers, we will treat them as a missing person and contact the relevant agencies as per our attendance policy & procedures.

The school completes an annual 175 Safeguarding audit to identify actions and monitor systems and procedures are effective.
