Spiritual Development

Children will develop by promoting the process of reviewing and evaluating their work, as well as promoting experiences to develop their own spirituality. They will also explore a variety of RE– related artwork such as nativity scenes.



Cultural Development

Children will develop culturally by experiencing a wide range of creative mediums and artists from around the world, including different cultures. They will develop their vocabulary and their ability to articulate it. Children will develop a critical awareness of artists, including their impact on the world. Children will also explore how cultures use art to express their values and beliefs.







Moral Development

Children will explore the environment and how art can be sensitive to its surroundings— creating temporary structures and using natural resources. Children will encourage the use of visual images to evoke a range of emotions. Children will develop a resilience to mistakes use this process positively. Children will also discuss the moral implications of art, such as black history month.





Social Development

Children develop socially by sharing resources and working on collaborative pieces together. They also develop by looking at the social links to art, such as propaganda in year 6. Children also work as a team to evaluate or improve their artwork together.
