

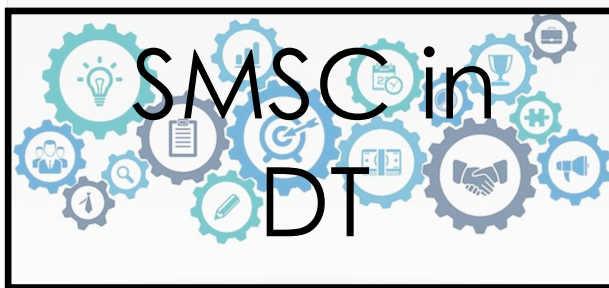
### Spiritual Development

By promoting safety inside and outside of DT lessons, to support their own respect of themselves and others. Children are taught to think creatively, and also to review and evaluate their products. Children also consider others when discussing the evaluation process.



### Moral Development

Children will explore the impact of the environment and take it into consideration when working. Children will explore sustainable materials and how to create them. Children will also consider the consumers use of the product and any moral dilemmas or issues that arise from this.



### Cultural Development

Children will develop culturally by discussing and evaluating a range of products through history and different cultures. Creating products that link to heritage will support this development. Children will also develop cultural products, and take into account cultural issues and designs when creating a product.



### Social Development

Promoting effective conversation through self and peer evaluation. Encourage working with others for collaborative products and when using technology so that children develop strong industry skills of working with others. Children develop constructive criticism skills.
