SMSC in Computing

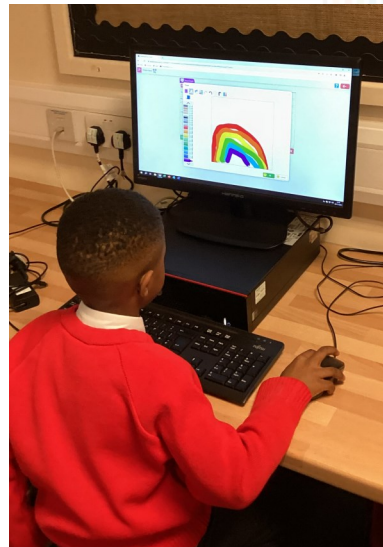


Cultural Development
