Year 5 – Construction and community architects, Williamson tunnel visit, Museum of Liverpool construction sessions, Wrexham football player session, Liverpool football coach, England Women's coach and scout – football session, lessons from Pro golfer- Liverpool's key Buildings visits.. Visit to university of Liverpool for Maths and computing.

Year 6 – The power of photography -Year 6 were due to learn about recycled fashion, being stewards of our planet, how communication has changed and in art and design –photography lessons, photoshoot in school, artist creating recycled fashion exhibition at Liverpool Hope, photography to not only learn these skills but develop their teamwork skills as they work across all year groups. be visiting Chester where we will be marching as a Roman army, visiting the amphitheatre, visiting the museum to explore the remaining Roman walls of the city and learning about


