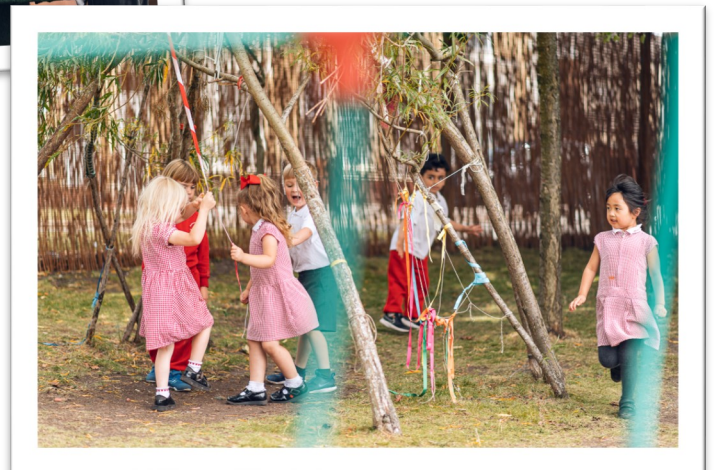
THE IMPORTANCE OF ARRIVING ON TIME—(08.45-08.55AM)

UN rights of the child: Setting up groups.

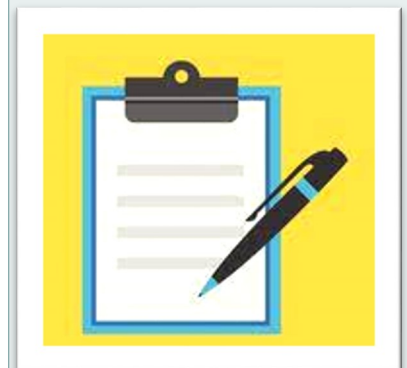
Children should always have the right to set up or join a group. We have been discussing this in school and what groups, such as clubs, we want in school, and how we can go about making positive change through these groups.
