We are currently reading a story called 'Zeraffa Giraffa' by Dianne Hofmeyr and have been working toward creating a promotional leaflet for the Jardins des Plantes in Paris. In order to further develop the children's writing skills we ask that they research another tourist attraction in Liverpool and create a leaflet promoting what there is to do there. We ask that children include persuasive language in their leaflet including word play, alliteration, rhetorical questions and commands.
