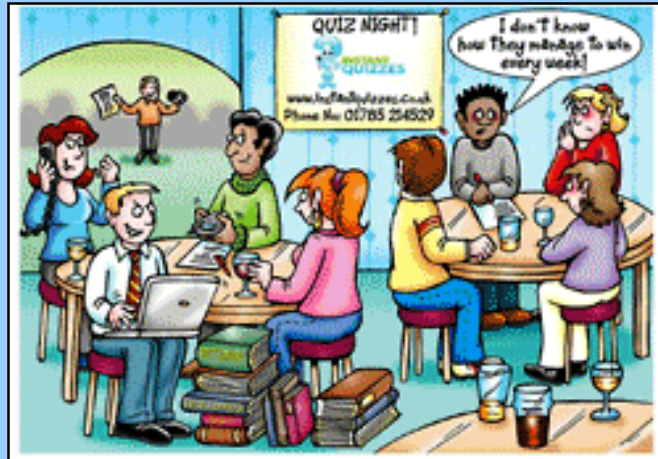

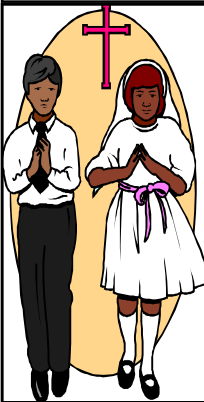

Faith Focus

The Bible - One book or many?

The Bible is not just one book, but a whole collection! There are 66 books split into two sections. 39 in the first largest part, called the **OLD TESTAMENT** and the second part, the **NEW TESTAMENT** has 27. The **OLD TESTAMENT** covers a sweep of history, from the creation of the world, to about 400 BC. Its books include poetry and history, prophecy and law. But they all tell the story of God's relationship with his people. The **NEW TESTAMENT**, covers the amazing life of Jesus, and what followed on. There are four accounts of Jesus' life, called the 'Gospels', written by those who knew Him. Then, in the book called 'Acts' there is the story of how His followers carried His message around the world.
