



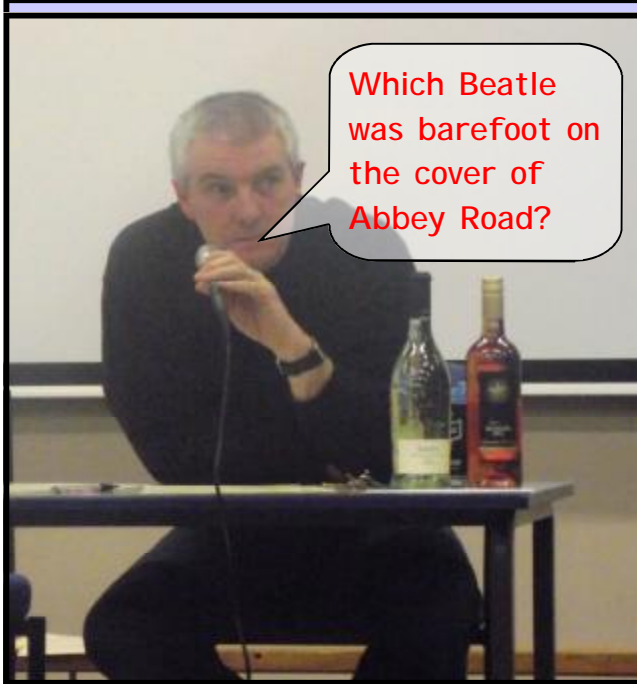

On Tuesday, Charlotte, Natalya, Dylan and Miss Barnes went to schools parliament in the town hall. They listened to 3 Jewish survivors who lived in Germany, Hitler was against the Jews. The survivors all grew up in Germany as innocent Jews with a good life but something extra terrible happened! Hitler came in to power but he hated Jews so badly that he made people stop buying from the Jews and that Jews could not buy from them. Then it became un-safe and eventually life risking playing in the streets because there would be some sort of danger around!

Sadly then there was no choice but for their parents to send them off on to a train to England, Poland or France. It was devastating! They all went to live with different families, they settled and made new lives but they didn't know if their parents were still alive. One of the Jewish survivors went back to Germany but one thing she did was not to communicate with any elderly person in case they had been part of the plan to kill Jews, she only talked to the younger generation who were really friendly indeed.

They went through a pretty rough time, if you can imagine, it's like people not being allowed to do things or even be allowed to live just because they look or believe something different from you. How unfair!!!!!!
