

Pastoral Letter

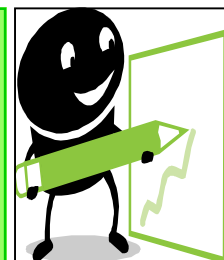
